**Re: Application to Withdraw Wireless Backup Leased Circuit Service**

Pursuant to paragraph 9 of Annex 5 of the ICT License issued to Cable and Wireless (Cayman Islands) Limited, trading as LIME ("**LIME**") on July 10, 2003 (the "**Licence**"), LIME hereby requests approval from the Authority to withdraw the tariff for LIME's Wireless Backup Lease Circuit service.

While LIME received approval to provide the service from the Authority on 21 August 2008, the expected demand for the service never materialized. As a result, LIME does not and never did have customers for the service. Further, LIME has made a strategic decision in the meantime to focus on providing leased circuit services via a fixed network. Consequently, LIME requests authorisation to withdraw the service from its Tariff and its list of authorised services
