#### NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO TRANSFER SHARES AND AMEND AN ICT LICENCE

#### PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 25 AND 31 OF THE INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY LAW (2006 REVISION)

#### APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF SHARES OF ICT LICENSEE AND LICENCE AMENDMENT

The ICT Authority has received an application by WestTel Limited (“WestTel”) for permission to transfer the WestTel shares held by WestStar TV Limited (“WestStar”) to KeyTech Limited (“KeyTech”). WestTel and WestStar are both incorporated in the Cayman Islands and KeyTech is incorporated in Bermuda. WestStar currently holds 33% of the WestTel shares and KeyTech holds the remaining 67%. Following completion of this transaction, KeyTech would hold 100% of the WestTel shares. As part of this application, WestTel also requested an amendment to Annex 1B of its ICT licence in order to delete the requirement that at least 25% of its equity be held by Caymanians. This application was filed by WestTel in accordance with sections 25 and 31 of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2006 Revision). Under section 25, the Authority’s consent to this transfer of shares should not be unreasonably withheld.
