The Authority has received extension requests for the responses to the interrogatories that were due on the 7 October 2009 from both Digicel and LIME.

Those extension requests are hereby approved.

In its procedures for this proceeding, the Authority required that any disclosure requests be made within ten calendar days of the material being filed.

As Digicel has indicated that it will respond to all of the interrogatories by 21 October 2009, the ten calendar day period for disclosure requests related to its interrogatory responses remains appropriate.

However, for the LIME interrogatory responses, the Authority is concerned that LIME's multistaged reply dates may complicate any disclosure process because of the possibility of multiple simultaneous request and reply phases at the same time that LIME is attempting to respond to the remaining interrogatories. Therefore, for the LIME interrogatory responses that were originally due on 7 October 2009, the Authority sets the due date for any disclosure requests for all of the LIME interrogatory responses to be within ten calendar days of the last batch of interrogatory responses being filed.
