**Re: ICTA Decision 2008-4**

We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of September 2009 wherein you state that you "received an application from DMS Broadcasting concerning the subject".

We would be obliged to know what kind of an application was made by DMS Broadcasting and how same has impacted on your decision to issue a cease and desist order as threatened by you in your letter of the 14<sup>th</sup> of August. If it is the case that DMS has made an application for Judicial Review, we fail to see how a stay could have been put on your decision pending the outcome in the absence of a Court Order. Your letter of the 14<sup>th</sup> of August 2009 specifically states that the Authority would not extend DMS' existing license beyond the 15<sup>th</sup> of September if they had failed to re-locate by that date.

Please confirm when the next meeting of the Authority's Board will be. Allowing DMS to continue broadcasting, for whatever reason, has seriously prejudiced our Client in that they continue to experience blanketing interference.
