Re: Interconnection Agreement

As you all are aware, the various Interconnection Agreements currently in force in the Cayman Islands will be expiring in 2009 and need to be renewed. LIME has provided you under separate cover a proposed Interconnection Agreement, and will be communicating with each of your companies in due course to finalize the renewal of the Interconnection Agreement. However, LIME considers that the rates to be charged for call termination and transit services merit separate discussions, and that the best results will be achieved if these discussions are held openly and transparently among all the parties.

When the current Interconnection Agreements were executed, LIME had hoped that the Authority would have implemented the forward-looking long-run incremental cost model and determined cost-based rates for call termination and transit services, prior to their expiry. For various reasons, it appears those new FLLRIC rates will not be available until some time later. Because of this, we are proposing that we apply the rates set out in the attached Tariff Schedule until such time as FLLRIC rates are determined. These rates can be summarized as follows (based on a three-minute call):

Fixed termination rate: CI\$ 0.01413 per minute
 Mobile termination rate: CI\$ 0.86400 per minute
 PSTN Transit rate CI\$ 0.00747 per minute

Because only the mobile termination rate in the current Tariff Schedules is not cost-oriented, we're proposing a 53% reduction in that rate which should bring it closer to what we expect will be cost-oriented rates in the long run. Call Durations are specified in this document as a charge of CI\$ per 60s. However, pursuant to the terms of the Service Descriptions, Calls will be measured to an accuracy of $1/10^{th}$ of a second, and the Charges will be the sum of the month's measurements rounded to the nearest minute.
