**Re: FLLRIC 3G model submission by C&W (Cayman)**

Digicel is writing to you concerning the FLLIRC 3G model that was recently submitted by C&W (Cayman) as part of the cost modeling process in the Cayman Islands.

The 2008-2 Decision allowed for a three month review period by all the other operators and was due, on May 18<sup>th</sup> 2009 after an extension. The revised model was eventually provided to Digicel on May 21<sup>st</sup> 2009.

Digicel is working with cost modeling consultants to populate the model as it does not currently have in-house expertise to comment comprehensively on what C&W has done. As the ICTA is most likely aware, there are few experts in the world able to do this type of cost modeling analysis exercise.

In our comments on the timelines in the initial proposal by the ICTA we indicated that whereas we can ourselves suggest possible dates or accept proposed dates for responding to the submission, we cannot rule out unforeseen circumstances which could have interfered with our ability to meet the proposed timelines.

Digicel will now need to request additional time to respond to the revised model that was submitted. Due to the fact that C&W opted not to use primitive data in the model and extensively employed dummy variables throughout, we simply cannot, with the best of internal efforts, submit the data in the required format to the consultants in the time allocated for this assignment.

Our consultants have now advised that they are only available for this assignment at the end of this month. They have further advised that they will thereafter need three weeks to review, comment and consult with us in order to prepare a proper response on the FLLRC 3G model. We anticipate it is likely that

the work can be completed in this time but there is a risk that the work could take a significantly longer time than envisaged.

The effect of the granting of additional time to C&W to submit the FLLRIC 3G model has created a knock on effect whereby Digicel will not be able to meet the July 7th 2009 deadline.

Based on the above, we are now requesting an extension of time from July 7<sup>th</sup> 2009 to August 7<sup>th</sup> 2009 to respond to the submissions completed by C&W on May 21<sup>st</sup> 2009.
