Subject: Digicel's FLLRIC Phase 3 disclosure request

To: FLLRIC Phase 3 distribution list

In a letter dated 25 November 2009, Digicel requested disclosure of certain information that was submitted by LIME in the FLLRIC Phase 3 proceeding.

In the Authority's 13 October 2009 email approving the extension requests by Digicel and LIME for the FLLRIC interrogatory responses, the Authority stated that any disclosure requests for all of the LIME interrogatory responses should be received within ten calendar days of the last batch of interrogatory responses being filed.

However, to date, the Authority has not received the LIME responses that were due on 21 October and LIME has been unable to identify when it will respond to those interrogatories.

In an effort to continue developing the record of the proceeding, the Authority considers that it should deal with Digicel's request for disclosure related to the two batches of LIME interrogatory responses that have been submitted rather than waiting until after the last batch of interrogatory responses have been filed.

Therefore, LIME is directed to provide any reply to Digicel's 25 November disclosure request by 18 December 2009 and to copy the FLLRIC distribution list on any such reply.

In addition, in regards to any disclosure request for the third batch of interrogatory responses and any future submissions in this proceeding, the Authority will revert back to the disclosure request procedure as identified in CD 2009-1. That is, the Authority requires that any disclosure requests be made within ten calendar days of the material being filed. Responses to disclosure requests and the determinations regarding such requests will be in accordance with the ICTA Confidentiality Regulations.
