Further to your correspondence of 4 May 2010, this is to confirm that the Authority has agreed to extend the deadline to implement LNP until **14 November 2010**.

The Authority requires the LNP Working Group to provide monthly status reports on the implementation of LNP. The Authority will expect to receive the first of these reports on 15 June 2010 and on the 15th day of each month thereafter (or next business day, if the 15th falls on a weekend or statutory holiday) until LNP is fully implemented. Following receipt of each report, the Authority will, if necessary, consider whether a further extension is warranted.

The Board of the Authority would also appreciate an opportunity to meet with the LNP Working Group in person in July or August (i.e. once a vendor has been selected) in order to discuss the LNP implementation process in more detail. Please confirm a date/time that would be suitable to the LNP Working Group (ideally on a Thursday at 9:00am, to coincide with the ICTA Board meetings).
