Re: Routing of Voice Calls in an LNP Environment

Dear Dr. Richardson,

Logic agrees that on the LNP Technical Committee meeting held on February 15th, 2011 by conference bridge it was one of 3 parties to agree in principal to using routing numbers. In more detail Logic agreed to perform our own query to the PortingXS database for all fixed calls and pass on to LIME with the correct routing number. For mobile related calls Logic agreed that we would pass on these calls to LIME for it to perform a query and add the routing number for a fee to be discussed in the future.

After consulting with our engineering and development team Logic decided to perform its own queries and addition of routing number to all calls not terminating in our home network before sending to LIME for eventual routing or termination.

In summary Logic is prepared to send all non home network calls to LIME with previously agreed routing numbers and a nature of address set to 8.
