The Authority notes that there was a typographical error on one of the dates specified in item 2) of the "Remaining Procedures" section on page 10 of its 13 December 2012 letter. The "14 February 2012" date should have been "31 January 2013".

For clarity, the remaining procedures, among other things, provided for a disclosure process related to submissions filed by 31 January 2013 by parties other than LIME. As those submissions did not include information subject to a claim of confidentiality, no disclosure process for these submissions is necessary.

Therefore, the next step in the process is that parties (including LIME) may address interrogatories to parties who have made submissions in this proceeding. In accordance with the procedures specified by the Authority, those interrogatories are due by **14 February 2013**.

Responses to any such interrogatories are due by **7 March 2013** and should be done in compliance with the procedures specified in the 13 December 2012 letter.
