McCleary Frederick is the Executive Director of Energy. A former civil servant who dedicated over 36 years of service to the people and government of the Cayman Islands. He held various positions throughout his career, starting as a trainee draughtsman and progressing to draughtsman and field supervisor at the Public Works Department (PWD).

After his time at PWD, he moved to the Department of Planning, where he served as a code enforcement officer, assistant building control officer, and chief building control officer. In this role, he played a crucial part in establishing and developing the Building Control Unit and contributed to the development and adoption of the Cayman Islands Building Code.

Mr. Frederick then transitioned to the former Portfolio of Internal and External Affairs, where he helped establish the permanent and full-time disaster management agency known as Hazard Management Cayman Islands (HMCI). He was initially appointed as Deputy Director of Mitigation before being promoted to Director of Hazard Management Cayman Islands.

In May 2017, Mr. Frederick became the first international recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award at the Florida Governor's Hurricane Conference. This award recognised his significant contributions to disaster management and building safety.

He retired from the civil service in December 2017, however, he returned to the Planning Department in April 2019, serving until July 2020 as the Assistant Director of Planning (Building), once again overseeing the Building Control Unit.

Throughout his career, Mr. Frederick has consistently encouraged the development of young Caymanians, providing them with opportunities for growth and advancement.
