



AMENDMENT NUMBER 1 TO THE LICENCE OF STARLINK (CAYMAN ISLANDS) LIMITED.

WHEREAS Starlink (Cayman Islands) Limited, was granted a Licence by Utility Regulation and Competition Office, dated 22nd December 2025;

AND WHEREAS Starlink (Cayman Islands) Limited has requested assignment of the following frequencies to facilitate direct to device mobile satellite services to ICT Licensees:

space-to-Earth (MHz)	Earth-to-space (MHz)
1518 – 1525	1668 – 1675
1525 – 1559	1626.5 – 1660.5
2483.5 – 2500	1610 – 1626.5
2180 – 2200	1990 – 2010

AND WHEREAS the Office agrees to the proposed assignment of the frequencies on a non-exclusive basis and considers it appropriate to amend the Annex 4 *Authorised Frequencies* assignment list;

THEREFORE pursuant to sections 23 and 31 of the Information and Communications Technology Act (2026 Revision), the list of *Authorised Frequencies* in Annex 4 of the Licence is hereby amended.

¹ The use of these frequencies is subject to compliance with any applicable coordination requirements under Article 9 of the ITU Radio Regulations and with any relevant ITU Radio Regulations and Cayman Islands national footnotes applicable to the bands concerned including, where applicable, engagement with relevant administrations and operators in order to facilitate coordination and mitigate harmful interference. Services provided using this spectrum shall, upon reasonable request by any ICT licensee in the Cayman Islands, be offered on a fair, reasonable, and non-discriminatory basis.

With respect to all assigned electromagnetic spectrum, the Licensee shall comply with the Electromagnetic Field (EMF) safety guidelines with respect to human exposure in accordance with The International Commission of Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection (ICNIRP) standards. In all cases the Licensee shall exercise due care when using electromagnetic spectrum so as not to cause harm to any person by exposure to EMF.
