As discussed, we are considering the issues raised in your consultation paper on DPI and would like to respond to the ICTA. In order to have the benefit of thorough internal consideration, it would be very much appreciated if you would be able to extend the deadline for responding. We realise that a provider is proposing to deploy DPI and that accordingly there is a time consideration, but the consultation period is very short. There are a number of people away (not surprising in August!) and we are therefore somewhat hampered in being able to consider this properly in the time available. I suspect others in the financial services industry may be in a similar position.

Given the importance of the issue and its potential implications, would you kindly consider a 30-day extension for our response?
