



FOI Requests 2019

On 25 September 2019, the applicant requested copies of all financial data provided to OfReg and its predecessor ICTA, by all current and former broadcasting licensees since the date of grant of their respective licenses, and copies of any waiver in respect of the provision of financial reporting given to any. On 29 October 2019, the applicant was notified the records were exempted from disclosure under section 21(1) (a) (ii) of the FOI Law.

On 2 October 2019, the applicant requested all materials received or created by OfReg coincident or pursuant to the application or approval of the license issued by OfReg to a company under Part iii of the Information and Communications Technology Authority (Confidentiality) Regulations. A copy of the license was provided to the applicant, some information was redacted under section 21(1)(a)(ii) of the FOI Law.

On 9 October 2019, the applicant requested (1) information on the applicable legislation, regulation, rule or order based on which Royalties are calculated by OfReg and collected from Licensees. (2) Is OfReg affiliated with, or otherwise vetted by, any international collection agency and/or are there any reciprocal agreements in place between OfReg and any international collection agency? (3) What is the total sum of the Royalties collected from Licensees by OfReg (and ICTA) over the past six years? (4) Who are the recipients of the Royalties collected by OfReg and the ICTA? On 22 October 2019 a copy of the ICT Law was provided to the applicant, they were advised to review section 30 which addresses license fees and outlines the obligation to pay the license fees prescribed by the office. Applicant was also advised financial information and licenses issued by OfReg are published on OfReg's website and that 100% of fees collected are paid to the CI Government.
