**AND WHEREAS** the Information and Communications Technology Authority is in agreement that Blue Sky Communications Ltd be provided with the 9.8 MHz of spectrum;

**THEREFORE** pursuant to sections 23 and 31 of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2004 Revision), Annex 4 of the Blue Sky Communications Ltd Licence dated 18 December 2003 is amended whereby the Licensee is licensed to an additional 9.8 MHz of spectrum, namely 1885 – 1894.8 MHz / 1965 – 1974.8 MHz;
