

AMENDMENT NO. 8 TO THE LICENCE OF BLUE SKY WIRELESS LTD

WHEREAS Blue Sky Wireless Ltd. is currently required, under the terms of its licence, to rollout various ICT networks and ICT services across the Cayman Islands in 2006 and 2007;

AND WHEREAS Blue Sky Wireless Ltd. has requested extensions to these rollout dates;

AND WHEREAS the Information and Communications Technology Authority concurs to amending Annex 1A of Blue Sky Wireless Ltd.'s Licence to reflect new rollout dates;

THEREFORE pursuant to sections 23 and 31 of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2006 Revision), Annex 1A of the Blue Sky Wireless Ltd. Licence is hereby amended.

ANNEX 1A

Roll Out Schedule

ICT SERVICES

Type 1 Service – Fixed Telephony

Fixed telephony services will be made available by 1 October 2008 in Grand Cayman and 1 December 2008 in the Sister Islands.

Type 3 Service – Mobile Telephony

Full CDMA (1900MHz) service will be made available in Grand Cayman by 31 March 2008 and launched commercially on 1 July 2008.

Full CDMA (1900MHz) service will be made available in the Sister Islands by 1 June 2008 and launched commercially on 1 Sep 2008.

Full GSM (850MHz) service will be made avalaible in Grand Cayman by 1 August 2008 and launched commercially on 1 October 2008.

Full GSM (850MHz) service will be made available in the Sister Islands by October 2008 and launched commercially on 1 December 2008.

On all the previous type 3-networks, service for roaming services will have the same availability dates as the commercial launch dates.

Type 4 Service – Resale of Telephony

Resale of Telephony service will be made available in Grand Cayman by 1 December 2008.

Type 5 Service - Internet Telephony

Internet Telephony services will be made available in Grand Cayman by 1 March 2009.

Type 9 Service – Internet Service Provider

Internet Service Provider (ISP) services will be provided by July 2008.

Type 11 Service - Provision of ICT Infrastructure to 3rd Parties

Provision of ICT Infrastructure to 3rd Parties will be available by 1 January 2009.

Type 12 Service – Resale of ICT equipment

Retail Sale of ICT Equipment will commence by 1 October 2008.

Type 14 Service – Application Service Provider

Application Service Provider (ASP) services will commence by 1 October 2008.

Type 15 Service - Video On Demand

Video on Demand services will be made available by 1 December 2008.

ICT NETWORKS

Type B Network – Fixed Wireless

The Fixed Wireless Network will be in place no later than 1 October 2008 in Grand Cayman and 1 December 2008 in the Sister Islands.

Type C2 Network - Mobile 2.5G

Mobile service will be in place no later than 1 July 2008 in Grand Cayman and 1 December 2008 in the Sister Islands. (CDMA 1900MHz)

Mobile service will be in place no later than 1 August 2008 in Grand Cayman and December 2008 in the Sister Islands (GSM 850MHz)

Type C3 Network – Mobile 3G

Mobile service will be in place no later than 1 July 2008 in Grand Cayman and 1 December 2008 in the Sister Islands. (EvDo 1900MHz)

Mobile service will be in place no later than 1 August 2008 in Grand Cayman and December 2008 in the Sister Islands (EDGE 850MHz)

Type D1 Network – Fiber Optic Cable / Domestic

The Fibre Optic Cable Network (Domestic) will be in place no later than 1 September 2009 in Grand Cayman.

Type E2 Network - Satellite / VSAT international

The International Satellite Network will be in place no later than 1 January 2010 in Grand Cayman and 1 June 2010 in the Sister Islands.
