

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE LICENCE OF CAYMAN ADVENTIST TV NETWORK

WHEREAS the Cayman Islands Conference of Seventh-Day Adventists has requested the assignment of the Licence granted 21 September 2006 to Mr. Everton Malcolm, trading as Praise 87.9FM, in accordance with section 25 of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2006 Revision);

AND WHEREAS the particulars of the proposed assignment were published in the Cayman Gazette as stipulated by subsection 27(3) of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2006 Revision);

AND WHEREAS the Information and Communications Technology Authority, having taken into consideration the matters referenced in subsection 26(2) and (3) of the Information and Communications Technology Authority Law (2006 Revision), consents to the proposed assignment.

AND WHEREAS the Information and Communications Technology Authority determines that the name of the Licensee, as stated on the Licence granted 15 June 2006 to Cayman Adventist TV Network, should be amended to Cayman Islands Conference of Seventh-Day Adventists to reflect the legal name of the Licensee pursuant to the Churches Incorporation Law (2007 Revision).

THEREFORE pursuant to sections 23, 25, 27 and 31 of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2006 Revision), Annex 1, 1A and 4 of Cayman Adventist TV Network's Licence is hereby amended.
