Dear Mr. Archbold,

Please find attached Digicel's comments on the 700 MHz public consultation process.

While the question regarding the band class that each operator would be interested in was not included in the consultation document, Digicel would like to state it is interested in Band Class12.

Also for further clarification we would like to provide the following explanation of terms:

1. Band Plan – overall plan for 700MHz
2. Upper and lower bands – top and lower half of 700MHz spectrum range respectively
3. Band Class – four of these from the 3G PP standards within 700 MHz – equipment should be designed by band class although word is the US operators may be making the equipment/handsets work in only their precise spectrum allocations within the band class.
4. Channelisation – really a reference to the old broadcasting way of 6 MHz chunks used for analogue TV. These could be combined/split up to make them consistent with the band classes above. To some extent the term is a bit redundant here I suppose.
