Re: ICTA FLLRIC Public Consultation - CD (2004) 1

In reviewing the process outlined by the Authority in CD (2004) 1 it has come to our attention that in Phase 1 of the proceeding the parties will not have an opportunity to respond to the comments filed by other parties on 20 August. Currently, the schedule is arranged such that the following events occur:

24 May 2004 C&W methodology filed

14 Jun 2004 Other parties issue interrogatories to C&W

30 Jul 2004 C&W responds to interrogatories

20 Aug 2004 Other parties file comments on C&W methodology

C&W permitted to file comments on its own methodology

October 2004 Authority issues preliminary decision on principles and guidelines

The current schedule permits C&W to file comments on its own methodology (which appears redundant), but it does not permit C&W to respond to the comments filed by other parties before the Authority makes its determination in October. The other parties have seen C&W's position in the methodology paper filed in May, and therefore will have an opportunity to respond to C&W's position in their comments on 20 August. The other parties' comments are effectively Reply Comments on C&W's proposed methodology. C&W does not have the same opportunity that other parties currently have in the proceeding.

C&W believes procedural fairness requires that it have the same opportunity to reply, and would like to file reply comments on 3 September. In this manner C&W will have an opportunity to respond to the comments filed by other parties on 20 August. While two weeks is sufficiently less time than other parties have to comment on C&W's methodology (other parties have over 12 weeks to prepare reply comments), we are making every effort to provide the Authority with sufficient time to meet its self-imposed October deadline. In the

interest of a complete record, we are also proposing that other parties to the proceeding have an opportunity to file further Reply comments on 3 September in which they can respond to anything filed by C&W on 20 August.
