Dear Mr. Brazeau,

On behalf of TeleCayman, in response to your written correspondence requesting clarification with regard to Indirect Access, our position is as follows:

- TeleCayman is of the opinion that only Facilities Based Carriers, licenced to provide International Connectivity, be authorized to provide Indirect Access on a 10-10-XXX basis.
- As you are aware, there are infrastructure vulnerabilities that potentially can result by allowing non-facilities based carriers in small jurisdictions with subscriber bases the size of the Cayman Islands. It is for this reason alone that we believe that a facilities based criteria must be given strong consideration as it pertains to specific carrier services (International Carrier Services in this case).
- With the threshold date for full liberalization of International Telecommunications in the Cayman Islands quickly approaching, we believe there should be some provisioning that protects those Licenced Carriers that have invested heavily in Telecommunications Infrastructure.

I trust this clarifies TeleCayman's position and invite you to contact me at the above number should you require additional explanation.
