ICT 2022 - 1 - Consultation Proposed Outage Reporting Rules Update 18 May 2022

The Utility Regulation and Competition Office ('OfReg') is notifying the public that it will launch a consultation on the proposed updates to its Information and Communications Technology sector Outage Reporting Rules. The Rules set out the procedure to be adhered to in the mandatory reporting of outages to Services and Networks affecting consumers, special entities and other licensees.

All interested parties are encouraged to review the consultation which is set to be launched on 18 May 2022. The Consultation paper can be accessed at www.ofreg.ky under the consultation tab.

OfReg encourages concerned parties considering participating in the Consultation process by commenting on the proposed updates to the Outage Reporting rules to provide detailed comments, supported by appropriate justifications, to the issues raised in this Consultation.
