Yes.

WestTel currently employs equipment which manages our traffic load efficiently such that majority of our customers experience expected bandwidth. We also employ this on the special request of corporate customers who may want their internal traffic managed to efficiently utilize their contracted bandwidth.

- c. Do you currently employ traffic management technology or techniques, other than DPI, such as traffic shaping or traffic throttling, that result in the control of a customer's bandwidth?

- d. If the answer to (a) or (c) is yes, describe in detail your Internet Traffic Management Policies.

We limit wireless residential P2P on a per customer basis from 4-12Kbyte/s upstream and 8 to 150Kbytes/s downstream depending on the time of the day and we limit corporate customer traffic based on specific customer request.
