

# AMENDMENT NO. 10 TO THE LICENCE OF DMS BROADCASTING LTD

**WHEREAS** dms Broadcasting Ltd. is currently is currently authorized, under the terms of its licence, to use the 949.000 MHz, 950.000 MHz, 953.000 MHz and 954.000 MHz frequencies for Studio-Transmitter Links (STL);

**AND WHEREAS** dms Broadcasting Ltd. has requested that the 949.000 MHz frequency be replaced with 955.500 MHz;

**AND WHEREAS** dms Broadcasting Ltd. is currently required, under the terms of its licence, to rollout a radio station tailored to the Sister Islands at 96.5 FM no later than 31 December 2007;

**AND WHEREAS** dms Broadcasting Ltd. has requested a new rollout date for this radio station;

**AND WHEREAS** the Information and Communications Technology Authority concurs to amending Annexes 1A and 4 of dms Broadcasting Ltd.'s Licence to reflect this new frequency allocation and to extend the rollout date for this radio station to 31 March 2008;

**THEREFORE** pursuant to sections 23 and 31 of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2006 Revision), Annexes 1A and 4 of the dms Broadcasting Ltd. Licence are hereby amended.

## Annex 1A

### **Roll Out Plan**

#### **ICT Network**

The Licensee's ICT Network is fully deployed on Grand Cayman as of the date of this amendment.

The Licensee will deploy an ICT Network offering a radio station tailored to the Sister Islands at 96.5 FM no later than 31 March 2008. On 9 January 2008, 1 February 2008, 3 March 2008 and 1 April 2008, the Licensee shall provide status reports to the Authority on the rollout of this radio station. Upon request from the Authority, the Licensee shall also allow the Authority's staff to visit its studio and broadcast facilities during regular business hours to monitor the rollout of this station.

The ICT Network offering HOT 104.1 FM will be deployed to Cayman Brac and Little Cayman by 31 March 2009. The Licensee may apply for the removal of this requirement provided that it has operated for at least twelve months, and for as long thereafter as it continues to operate, to the Authority's satisfaction, the radio station tailored to the Sister Islands (96.5 FM).

#### **ICT Services**

The Licensee's ICT services identified as CAYROCK 96.5 FM, Hot 104.1 FM, KISS 106.1 FM, and X 107.1 FM are fully deployed on Grand Cayman as of the date of this amendment.

The Licensee will deploy an ICT Service offering a radio station tailored to the Sister Islands at 96.5 FM no later than 31 March 2008. On 9 January 2008, 1 February 2008, 3 March 2008 and 1 April 2008, the Licensee shall provide status reports to the Authority on the rollout of this radio station. Upon request from the Authority, the Licensee shall also allow the Authority's staff to visit its studio and broadcast facilities during regular business hours to monitor the rollout of this station.

The ICT Service offering HOT 104.1 FM will be deployed to the Cayman Brac and Little Cayman by 31 March 2009. The Licensee may apply for the removal of this requirement provided that it has operated for at least twelve months, and for as long thereafter as it continues to operate, to the Authority's satisfaction, the radio station tailored to the Sister Islands (96.5 FM).

<sup>\*</sup> The requested assignment of the ICT Licence of CAYROCK 96.5 FM (formerly Style 96.5 FM Ltd.) to dms Broadcasting Ltd. is hereby granted, subject to the conditions that the present antenna location and effective radiated power be maintained, to be changed only upon approval of a subsequent application to the Authority. Furthermore, the frequency of 96.5 MHZ is itself subject to change, should the Authority, in consultation with Cayman radio broadcasting community, determine to pursue further the initiatives to harmonize assigned frequencies at fourth or third adjacent, as discussed at the meeting held on 20 April 2006.
