Re: Interconnection Agreement and Confidentiality Claim

Cable & Wireless Cayman Islands Limited and TeleCayman Limited have reached agreement on all issues regarding interconnection of their two networks in the Cayman Islands. The Parties hereby file the attached final Interconnection Agreement as per Section 45 (1) of the *Information and Communications Technology Authority Law, 2002* and Section 22 (1) of the *Information and Communications Technology Authority (Interconnection and Infrastructure Sharing) Regulations, 2003*.

The Parties request that the Tariff Schedule, and in particular the details of the Optical In-Span Joining Service and the "Mobile Termination Part" of the PLMN Terminating Access Service usage charges, in the attached Interconnection Agreement be designated as "confidential". This request is made pursuant to Section 3(b) and (3)(d) of the *Information and Communication Technology Authority (Confidentiality) Regulations, 2003* (the "Regulations"). Disclosure of this information would reveal the positions taken by the Parties during confidential negotiations, and would enable competitors to have sensitive commercial information which could put the Parties at a competitive disadvantage.


The Parties are filing a redacted version of the Tariff Schedule, pursuant to Regulation 4(1)(c)(ii) of the Regulations.
