Amendments to Interconnection Agreement

As you are aware Cable & Wireless Cayman Islands Limited ("C&W") and Digicel Cayman Ltd ("Digicel") (the "Parties") filed on 29 January 2004 an interconnection agreement as per Section 45 (1) of the Information and Communications Technology Authority Law, 2002 and Section 22 (1) of the Information and Communications Technology Authority (Interconnection and Infrastructure Sharing) Regulations, 2003.

We are now informing you of amendments that have been made to that interconnection agreement. These amendments are without prejudice to the outcome of the negotiations between C&W and Digicel in July with respect to the imputation tests for and legality of C&W mobile packages and the mobile termination rate. The amendments to the interconnection agreement are included in the attached revised Schedules and are as follows:

Service Description

The agreement has been modified to add the Incoming International Call Termination to PSTN Service, as well as to allow for Digicel to bring international traffic in to the Cayman Islands for termination on C&W's PLMN.

Service Schedule

This has been updated to reflect the changes made in the Service Description.

There is a new reference to an additional number range allocated by the Authority to Digicel: 325 xxxx

Parameter Schedule

This schedule has been updated to reflect the addition of the Incoming International Call Termination to PSTN Service.

Definitions

This schedule has been amended to add the terms "Incoming International Call Termination to PSTN Service" and "Incoming International PSTN Termination Calls" which are used in the new Service Description.

Tariff Schedule

This has been updated to include tariffs for the new service mentioned above.

Apart from these specific changes there is no intent by either party to change any other parts of the interconnection agreement except purely to ensure correct formatting (paragraph numbers and the like). In the event that any other part of the interconnection agreement is not the same as the original agreement as signed on 29 January 2004 that shall be deemed to be purely accidental and the relevant part of the original agreement submitted to the ICTA shall prevail. The Parties agree to retain records of the original agreement for the purposes of verification in the event that any inconsistency should arise.

The Parties have agreed that the Incoming International Call Termination to PSTN Service will commence on 10 August 2004. Digicel will also be able to bring international traffic in to the Cayman Islands for termination on C&W's PLMN from the same date.
