Re: ICT Decision 2012-2 – FLLRIC Decision – Process on FTR and Transit Rates

Cable and Wireless (Cayman Islands) Limited, trading as LIME (“**LIME**”) writes further to its 31 May 2012 letter on the above subject. LIME recommends that the presently-interim fixed termination rates (“**FTR**”) and transit rates in its Interconnection Agreement with Digicel Cayman Limited be made permanent. While LIME would be foregoing the risk of an increase or decrease in those rates, LIME submits that this would create regulatory certainty and would ensure equitable treatment among all operators in the Cayman Islands market, as all operators would be charging and paying the same FTR and transit rates.

Notwithstanding this, LIME believes there remains a need for the Authority to determine FLLRIC-based FTR and transit rates, and requests therefore that the Authority continue to review the fixed module of the FLLRIC model, with a view to establishing new FTR and transit rates on a prospective basis.
